Do you know if there is a possibility to do this for my engine? And if so, I understood from previous dicussions on this website that I have to block the pulse hole of the VRO-pump and unscrew the pulse hole of the fuel pump, which should be somewhere behind the starter??Year of Manufacture : This is important in any repair, for obvious reasons. Prior to 1979, Johnson used the last 2 digits of the year in the model number. As a model 10R78M, would indicate a 10 hp, Rope starter, 1978 year of manufacture and M m odel revision. Since this does not have in the code L between the hp designation and the year, that would mean it is a short shaft version.
